Planning for Peace – Understanding Multidimensionality and Integration in UN Peace Operations

July 7 – 9 and 17 – 18 | FSU Jena

The IOCM Summer School 2023 explores the relevance of two essential characteristics of current United Nations Peace Operations (UNPOs): multidimensionality and integration. In doing so, it reviews the historical development, purposes, functioning, and challenges of UNPOs and focuses on the implications of missions' multidimensional character. It further investigates the relevance of integrated mission planning by exploring the logic, role, and strategy of the actors involved. The highlight of the summer school will be a 2-day simulation of an Advanced Mission Headquarters that operates in a chosen conflict setting. During the simulation, participants assume particular roles in given mission components (political, humanitarian, and military affairs) and develop plans and strategies to implement the mission's mandate.
